Speaking Hope to the World

Please pray for the Pettinger family. Andrew is Technical Manager at TWR-UK and needs to keep constantly updated with changes in technology which seems to get harder with advancing years!

Lesley now works on the Bronchoscopy Unit at Wythenshaw

Hospital in Manchester, as well running the CAP food cupboard and is on their church stewarding team.

Remember their children too: Becky has completed her college course and has started a new job as a Pharmacy Technician at the Christie Hospital; Tim has applied for a number of jobs but as yet has been unable to find paid employment. He still lives in Southampton and helps to lead the ministry to international students at Above Bar Church.

Over the past year TWR worldwide has continued to be involved in a number of projects, including:

- launching new transmitters broadcasting to Nigeria and Central Asia.
- providing mp3 players pre-loaded with biblical teaching to isolated Christians in countries where they are persecuted
- the growth of the TWR360, where people can access Gospel messages, music, videos (including the Jesus film) and audio Bibles, all now available in 75 languages.

A mobile phone app of TWR360 is downloaded by more people in Iran than any other country outside of the USA! Please pray for TWR's Persian ministry coordinator who counsels many believers after they have responded to the programmes. This includes numerous Christians experiencing high levels of persecution, believers who have fled the country as refugees and those who've returned from prison where they've been subjected to trauma and suffering.
